Love to cook? Share your creations with the Neighbour Night program to help a group of amazing residents build relationships and livelihood assets!

Neighbour Night is an informal peer support program that brings together Hillhurst Sunnyside community members to build new friendships while engaging in various recreation activities and workshops that participants have selected. The program runs every Thursday between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. Each session begins with sharing a meal, followed by an activity or workshop.

The responsibilities of a Neighbour Night Volunteer Cook are to:

- Plan, prepare, and cook a healthy, vegetarian meal for Neighbour Night
- Inform the Community Connections Coordinator of any ingredients needed for the meal to ensure everything you need is ready to cook when you arrive
- Clean up related materials and spaces after use

Volunteer Cooks would ideally be available on Thursdays leading up to the 6pm dinner service, OR the volunteer could prepare the meal at an earlier time or date and leave instructions for serving.

All volunteers are invited to join the group dinner each week.
